Directions by car

The traffic situation around Eindhoven has changed with the A2 becoming a super highway directing traffic around Eindhoven. The A2 has a parallel lane - the N2 ring-road / Randweg N2 – which provides traffic with local access to the exit and slip roads around Eindhoven. Approaching Eindhoven, be careful NOT to follow the A2, but follow the N2. On the map, you can see where to take the junction to the N2.

From Den Bosch:

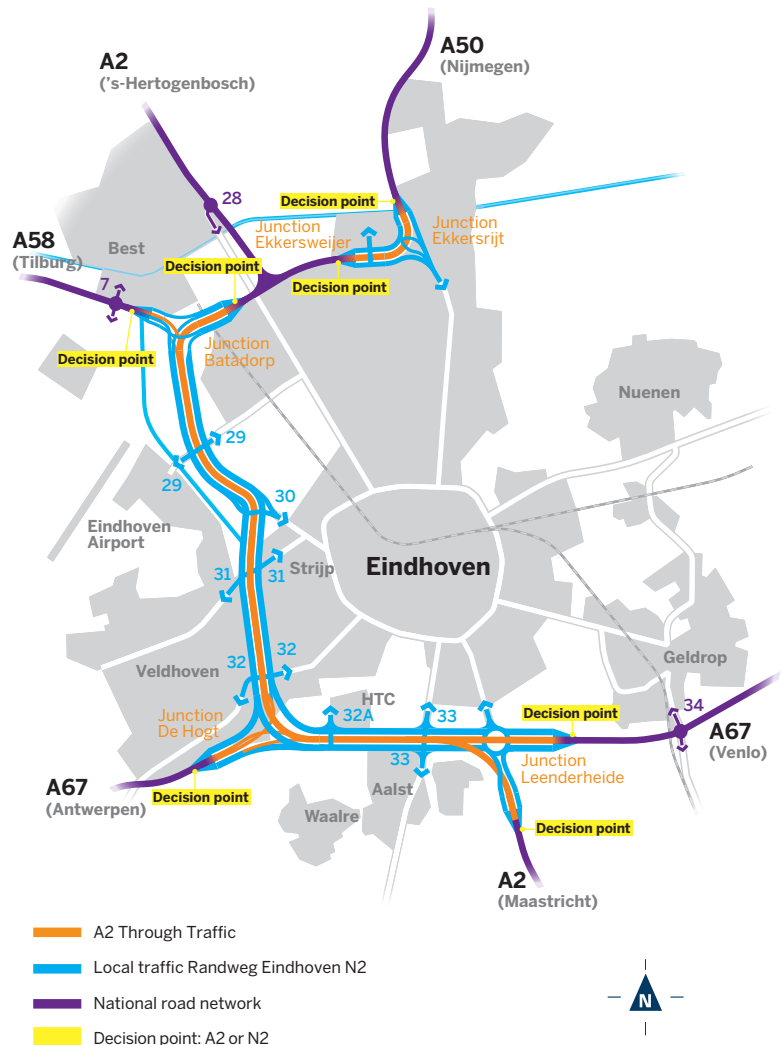
From Den Bosch, you approach Eindhoven via the A2. At the Ekkersweijer junction keep right, direction Randweg (ring-road) Eindhoven [A2/A58]. Stay on the parallel lane towards the Randweg Eindhoven [N2]. From the N2, take exit 29 towards Eindhoven Airport. At the end of the exit slip road, turn right at the traffic lights, direction Eindhoven Airport / Meerhoven. Then, follow the directions explained below under: 'Exit 29, Eindhoven Airport.'

From Tilburg:

From Tilburg you approach Eindhoven via the A58. At the Batadorp junction, follow the Randweg Eindhoven (the N2 parallel lane). From the N2, take exit 29, direction Eindhoven Airport. At the end of the exit slip road, turn right at the traffic lights, direction Eindhoven Airport / Meerhoven. Then, follow the directions explained below under: 'Exit 29, Eindhoven Airport.'

From Maastricht:

From Maastricht you approach Eindhoven via the A2. At the Leenderheide junction follow the Randweg Eindhoven (the N2 parallel lane). At the junction De Hogt, keep right following the direction 'overige richtingen (other routes)/ Randweg Eindhoven' [N2]. From the N2, take exit 29 towards Eindhoven Airport.



At the end of the exit slip road, turn left at the traffic lights direction Eindhoven Airport / Meerhoven. From there, follow the directions explained below under: 'Exit 29, Eindhoven Airport.'

From Venlo:

From Venlo you approach Eindhoven via the A67. At the Leenderheide junction, turn right and follow the Randweg Eindhoven (the N2 parallel lane). At junction De Hogt, keep right following direction 'overige richtingen (other routes) / Randweg Eindhoven' [N2]. From the N2, take exit 29 towards Eindhoven Airport. At the end of the exit slip road, turn left at the traffic lights direction Eindhoven Airport / Meerhoven. From there, follow the directions explained below under: 'Exit 29, Eindhoven Airport.'

From Antwerp:

From Antwerp you approach Eindhoven via the A67. At the De Hogt junction, keep left and follow the Randweg Eindhoven (the N2 parallel lane). From the N2, take exit 29 towards Eindhoven Airport. At the end of the exit slip road, turn left at the traffic lights direction Eindhoven Airport / Meerhoven. From there, follow the directions explained below under: 'Exit 29, Eindhoven Airport.'

Exit 29, Eindhoven Airport:

Take the left hand lane and after about 500 metres you will see the sign displayed below. You need to turn left into the Flight Forum. Please note: this turning can be easily missed!

- Turn left onto the inner ring.
- Drive on the inner ring, passing both Deloitte and AKD Prinssen van Wijmen offices.
- At the Getronics building, turn left and follow the road round to the right.
- Drive straight towards the parking garage of the Van Gansewinkel Groep

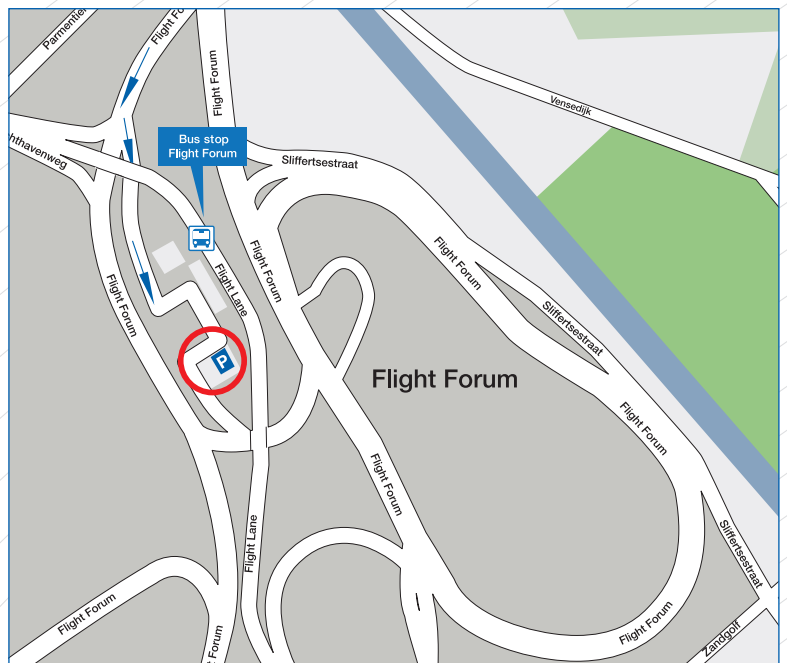


Directions by public transport from Eindhoven Central Station:

Take bus 401 towards Eindhoven Airport. Alight at the Forum Flight stop. Walk 30 metres back in the direction the bus came from. Cross the street and walk between the last two buildings and down the stairs. The left hand building (clad with dark stone) is the Van Gansewinkel Groep headquarters. Walk straight on for a further 20 metres and then turn left around the corner, where you will find the entrance.

Directions by public transport from Eindhoven Airport:

Take bus 401 towards Eindhoven Central Station. Alight at the Forum Flight stop. Walk 30 metres in the same direction that the bus is going. Cross the street and walk between the last two buildings and down the stairs. The left hand building (clad with dark stone) is the Van Gansewinkel Groep headquarters. Walk straight on for a further 20 metres and then turn left around the corner, where you will find the entrance.
